- On eleven days this month, January 2nd through the 11th and on the 26th, a significant amount of rainfall was experienced in the region that adversely affected ridership on RTA's most popular routes. For these rainy days, there was a decrease in ridership of 40,207 passengers as compared to last year, in which only one day of significant rainfall was encountered in the month of January.

- Effective September 26, 2004 Route 3 was realigned, deleting service to the Wal-Mart on Mc Kinley in Corona, and now laying over at the Vintage Terrace Senior Center located at Magnolia and Fullerton Avenue.

▲ Service began on Routes 202, 204, 206, and 208 September 2, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes seven months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only five months in fiscal year 2004.

Δ Service began on the Taxi Demonstration Program October 6, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes seven months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only four months in fiscal year 2004.
