The FY to date variance is the difference between ridership from July 2004 through March 2005 versus July 2003 through March 2004. The monthly variance is the difference between ridership from March 2005 versus March 2004.

- On four days this month, March 22nd through the 24th and on the 28th, a significant amount of rainfall was experienced in the region that adversely affected ridership on RTA's most popular routes. For these rainy days, there was a decrease in ridership of 5,541 passengers as compared to last year, in which only two days of significant rainfall was encountered in the month of March.
 - Effective September 26, 2004 Route 3 was realigned, deleting service to the Wal-Mart on Mc Kinley in Corona, and now laying over at the Vintage Terrace Senior Center located at Magnolia and Fullerton Avenue.

▲ Service began on Routes 202, 204, 206, and 208 September 2, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes nine (9) months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only seven (7) months in fiscal year 2004.

Δ Service began on the Taxi Demonstration Program October 6, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes nine (9) months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only six (6) months in fiscal year 2004.
