* Fiscal year 2007 ridership reflects both boarding increases and adjustments. The natural monthly increase for Routes 202, 206, and 208 ranged from 20% to 51%, and Route 204 declined 12%. For September 2005, the monthly ridership for the Commuter Link routes were unaccounted by approximately 3% to 36%. The natural YTD increases for Routes 202, 206, and 208 ranged from 22% to 57%, and Route 204 declined about 3%. For July to September 2005, the YTD ridership for the Commuter Link routes were unaccounted by approximately 5% to 38%.
