Fare adjustments for fixed routes and demand response services were recently implemented effective April 3, 2005. The dial-a-ride routes serve exclusively seniors and persons with disabilities.
 - Effective September 26, 2004 Route 3 was realigned, deleting service to the Wal-Mart on Mc Kinley in Corona, and now laying over at the Vintage Terrace Senior Center located at Magnolia and Fullerton Avenue.

▲ Service began on Routes 202, 204, 206, and 208 September 2, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes nine (9) months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only seven (7) months in fiscal year 2004.

Δ Service began on the Taxi Demonstration Program October 6, 2003. Therefore, the Fiscal Year (FY) to Date variance includes nine (9) months for fiscal year 2005 compared to only six (6) months in fiscal year 2004.
