### Updates

- Beaumont- July brought some Route changes: 1- Commuter Link 120 added a 2<sup>nd</sup> bus which gives more service and frequency. 2- Route 2 had a change as well; it services Beaumont and connects passengers via the I-10 freeway to the Casino. July \$0.25 youth fare as well as wear the color R.E.D. to Remember Everyone Deployed to win a monthly bus pass.
- RTA- \$0.25 youth fare continuing through Labor Day. Token Transit readers being outfitted on buses and will be rolled out in Fall. RTA having a trolley in the Stagecoach days parade.
  - o Art Welch thanks RTA for donating a bus to the Boys & Girls Club.
- Sunline- Annual “Pack the Bus” saw 821 backpacks and school supplies donated. September service changes are primarily effecting the Route 111. Token Transit on a pilot for 1 year with visual validation and perhaps readers on their buses after that.
- Morongo- DAR driver hired; DAR continues steady ridership.
  - o Conversation: Morongo DAR open to anyone who is traveling to Morongo Enterprises (casino, bowling, etc) from Banning/Beaumont area with a reservation. Cost is \$1.00. Interested parties should go to the travel center on the reservation and apply.
