Minutes Approved

Presentation- CVAG regarding CV LINK

- An alternative transportation plan that will connect desert cities with a paved path for pedestrians, bicyclists, and low speed electric vehicles.
- Purpose/Benefits are to pull people off of congested streets and offer other mobility options. Will relieve congestion, is good for the environment, improves tourism, creates jobs and improves health.
- 100 million dollars in grants, from many sources, are being used to complete the project.
- Project has completed its first leg of the link from Ramon to Vista Chino and is expected to complete the rest by 2024.

Presentation- RCTC regarding Route 60 Truck Lane Project

- From Gilman Springs to 1.4 miles west of Jack Rabbit Trail
- 2.5 year project starting late May 2019; estimated completion late 2021
- One westbound lane will be closed permanently from July – December 2019; at no time will eastbound lanes be closed.
- Project is going to widen the highway into 3 lanes in each direction
- Going to give standard shoulder widths; 11' inside shoulder and 12' paved outside shoulder. There will also be an 18' unpaved shoulder outside of the 12' shoulder
- Construction will straighten out the road
- Freeway Service Patrol will be available in the area for the 6 months WB lane is closed, for 12 hours out of the day.
