**Minutes Approved – Change to Morongo Dial-a-Ride update**

**Presentation – State Route 60 Truck Lane Project**

**Updates**

- Beaumont- Recent changes include: 1- Commuter Link 120 added a 2<sup>nd</sup> bus which gives more service and frequency. 2- Route 2 had a change as well; it services Beaumont and connects passengers via the I-10 freeway to the Casino.
- RTA- \$0.25 youth fare saw nearly 200,000 boardings this summer, a 5% increase from 2018. The RTA Board elected Wildomar City Councilmember Bridgette Moore Chair and Norco Mayor Pro Tem Berwin Hanna as Vice Chair, replacing Murrieta City Councilmember Randon Lane who resigned after taking a position with the U.S. Department of Transportation.
- Sunline- Extending their successful Hall Pass program to public high schools. High school students will ride the bus for free during the two-year pilot program.
- Morongo- Clarified that their dial a ride program is not available to the general public as stated at the August meeting. Service is only provided for members of the tribe.
- Rail- No update
- AQMD- Clean Air Awards are coming up, will send out a flyer to the group.

- Discussed an event the Riverside T-NOW chapter is organizing on October 10. Members are invited to tour the RTA facility before taking a bus ride on RTA Route 200 to Disneyland. Chapter members should RSVP if interested in attending.
