- a. APTA Local Coalition Grant
 - The chapter discussed the APTA Local Coalition Grant video and were informed that the video views far exceeded the 100,000-goal set. Members were thanked for helping promote the video on their social networks.

- RTA will once again offer youths 25 cent fares during the holidays and will award a contract to a vendor to begin development of a mobile fare option for passengers.
