2019 Meeting Schedule and Sponsors

- 1) Calendar of sponsors was distributed
- 2) Change to the calendar: July is dark and August we will meet on the 1st.

Transportation Updates-

- 1) Beaumont- Because of a recent visit from Cal Trans to audit LCTOP grant money, Beaumont will be extending their Free Fare from just college and veterans to all passengers on Beaumont routes January to March 2019. Since Route 2 is an issue for Banning, City Managers are going to meet and come up with a plan so that the project does not affect Banning operations.
- 2) Banning- None
- 3) Morongo- None
- 4) RTA-
 - a. Festival of lights is underway and a free shuttle from Riverside Metrolink Station is in operation.
 - b. .25 holiday fare also to be offered December 21-January 12 and will include all of RTA system.
 - c. Token Transit will be offered in the spring system wide.
- 5) Rail- Suggestion made to have Metrolink pair up and work together with rail to accomplish progressive movement.

Sub Group Updates-

- 1) Travel Training- Year in review by Ron Roy: Went over his checklist and discussed that we have made progress over the year. 1st/last mile still needs some work. But new routes, such as Commuter 125 (Pass Transit) and Commuter 200 (RTA) makes it easier to get around.
- 2) Veterans- January 26, 2019 is the annual expo. Beaumont Pass Transit offers free rides already, but Anita would like to request RTA, Sunline and Banning to also offer free rides to those attending Expo.

Local Coalition Update-

- 1) 100,000 view on FB
- 2) Length of video was 1 min 45 seconds and the average time the video was watched was 1 min 30 seconds.
- 3) 75,000 people viewed on YouTube.
- 4) Overall, a successful project. Over 200,000 people reached.
